Beach Volleyball Advisory Committee (BVAC)

Terms of Reference

- BVAC is an Advisory Committee and intended to comprise personnel with a
 broad cross section of knowledge and experience in Beach Volleyball and will
 consider a diverse range of strategic and operations matters such as the
 Australian Beach Volleyball Tour (ABVT), domestic and international program of
 events, National Ranking Points System, and related events and programs that
 can consolidate and enhance the importance of beach volleyball in Australia, and
 the role of Australia as a leading nation in the sport of beach volleyball globally.
- 2. BVAC will also have a mandate to seek views from the wider beach volleyball community to ensure its considerations are informed by a rich and nationally sourced breadth of opinion.

BVAC Structure

- 1. The VA board will appoint a Chairperson.
- 2. BVAC should consist of a Chairperson and 5 elected members and 3 VA staff to support the BVAC.
- 3. BVAC shall meet up to 6 times per year by teleconference or video conference.
- 4. The agenda of each meeting will be approved by the Chairperson. VA staff will circulate the agenda and all meeting notes.
- 5. BVAC will be supported by the following VA personnel who as a group will consider and elevate recommendations from the Committee to the VA Senior Management Group for determination:
