## COURSE OUTLINES

### Level 1 Coaches Course (National and Regional)

**Registration Deadline: 26 April 2019**

The course is open to anyone who wishes to learn more, and to start on the Coaches Pathway. They need to be committed to applying their knowledge and skills to the development of teams and clubs in their nation. Coaches with previous Volleyball/FIVB experience who wish to become involved in Para Sport will be particularly welcome.

All candidates will be expected to participate in practical sessions. The use of numbered shirts is encouraged. However, candidates should not go to the expense of buying a numbered shirt.

The course will include sessions on the following, but not necessarily in this sequence:

- Introduction
- Video Session
- History and Development of the game
- World ParaVolley Coaches Structure and Pathway
- Introduction to Classification – Who Can Play?
- Basic Rules and Regulations
- Let's Play – Organisation and Observation
- Training Principles
- Playing Techniques
- Exercises and Problem Solving
- Practical Exam
- Feedback/Evaluation

\*Candidates will receive either a Level 1 Diploma or a Certificate of Attendance, depending on their performance.

**Qualification Requirements:** It is highly recommended that all Candidates be able to converse in, and read and write basic English.

#### Quota:

- Each nation may normally register not more than two (2) candidates (one more in case of a female student). Extra candidates can be registered by agreement with the course organisers.
- The organising member nation can register not more than five (5) candidates, unless the course is not full at the registration deadline.
- This clinic is planned for a maximum of 20 candidates.

## Level 1 Classification Course (National)

**Registration Deadline: 26 April 2019**

Candidates must be Nationally-recognised and authorised to practice as a Medical Doctor or Physiotherapist. In the case of a physiotherapist the candidate must have completed a minimum three-year course. Proof of qualification and CV should be forwarded with the Course Registration Form.

## Level 2 Referee Course (Zonal qualification)

**Registration Deadline: 26 April, 2019**

The course is open to any referee with experience in Volleyball minimally at the regional or national league level. Referees with previous experience in collaborating with people with a physical impairment will be particularly welcome. Because of the movement required by Sitting Volleyball referees the role is unfortunately not suited to those in wheelchairs or with considerable movement problems.

The course will include sessions on the following, but not necessarily in this sequence:

### Technical ability

- *Study of the current Rules of the Game: Sitting; Beach ParaVolley (Standing)*
- *Detailed study of rule differences for Volleyball for athletes with physical impairment*
- *Interpretation of the Rules of the Game*
- *Study of game mechanics*
- *Application of Official Hand Signals & Line Judge Signals*
- *Explanation of the regular and beach Score-sheet*

### Human ability

- *Introduction on the Role of the Referee & the Referee Code of Conduct*
- *Referee Match and Event Preparation*
- *Managing in-game relationships*
- *Profile of a good official*

### Practical part and evaluation

- *Officiate as first, second and reserve referee*
- *Participate as Line Judge, scorer and assistant scorer*
- *Score sheet Examination*
- *Theory Written Examination*
- *Practical Examination*

\*Candidates will receive either a Level 2 Diploma or a Level 1 Diploma, depending on their performance.

All candidates must bring their own whistle and national referee uniform and should be prepared to play in practical sessions (playing clothes). Numbered shirts are encouraged for the practical sessions.

### **Qualification Requirements**

- Active qualified referees of a high regional or national level supported by the national federation of a member nation.
- Candidates must be able to read and write in basic English as the course and the written examination are delivered in English.
- The course will be opened in priority to nations do not have referees for their national program. Available space left will be opened to other nations to complete the course.

### **Quota:**

- Each nation may normally register not more than two (2) candidates (one more in case of a female student). Extra candidates can be registered by agreement with the course organizers.
- This clinic is planned for a maximum of six (6) candidates, depending of the number of matches available for evaluation.

**IMPORTANT:**

The World ParaVolley Level 2 Referee Diploma entitles the referee to officiate only in the World ParaVolley zone of residence and to only be appointed to national and zone events (but not Zonal Championships and World Qualification Events). L2 Referee appointments are made by the Zone Referee Commissioner.
